## CANCELLATION OF REPRESENTATION ARRANGEMENTS REVIEW

In April 2009, the Franklin District Council commenced its review of representation arrangements for the 2010 triennial elections - a requirement under sections 19 H and J of the Local Electoral Act 2001.

Public notice of an initial proposal (confirming the current representation arrangements) was made on 30 April 2009, and submissions were invited. When the submission period closed on 28 May 2009, no submissions had been received.

However, during May 2009, Parliament introduced and passed into law (on 25 May 2009) the Local Government (Tamaki Makaurau Reorganisation) Act 2009. Section 32(b) of this Act does not require any existing local authority (which includes the Franklin District Council) to undertake a representation arrangements review under the Local Electoral Act 2001.

Accordingly, notice is given that the representation arrangements review commenced by the Franklin District Council has been cancelled.
